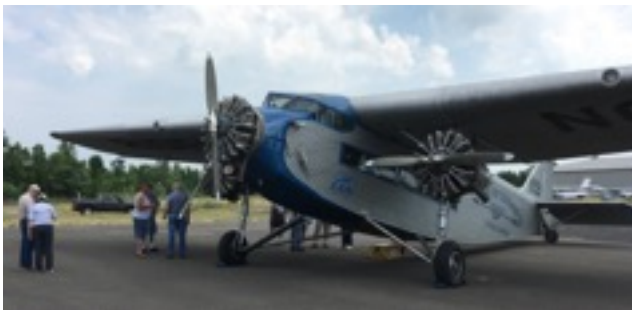
Does it get any better than this? Have a great weekend experiencing the "Golden Age of Aviation."

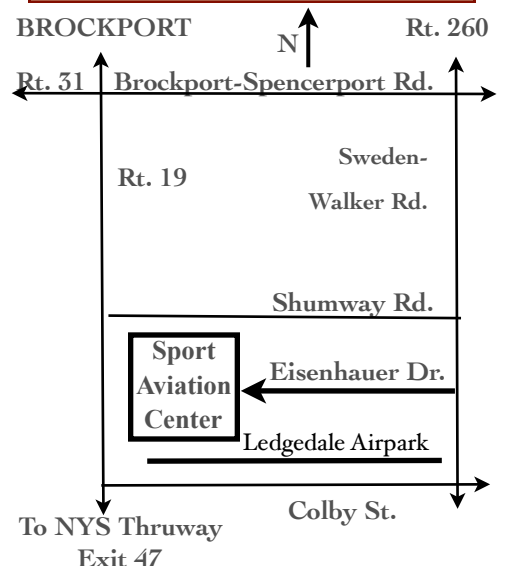
