Also featured at this event will be an antique car show, a Sock Hop, and a veteran's display. Katy's Fly-In Restaurant is right across the street.

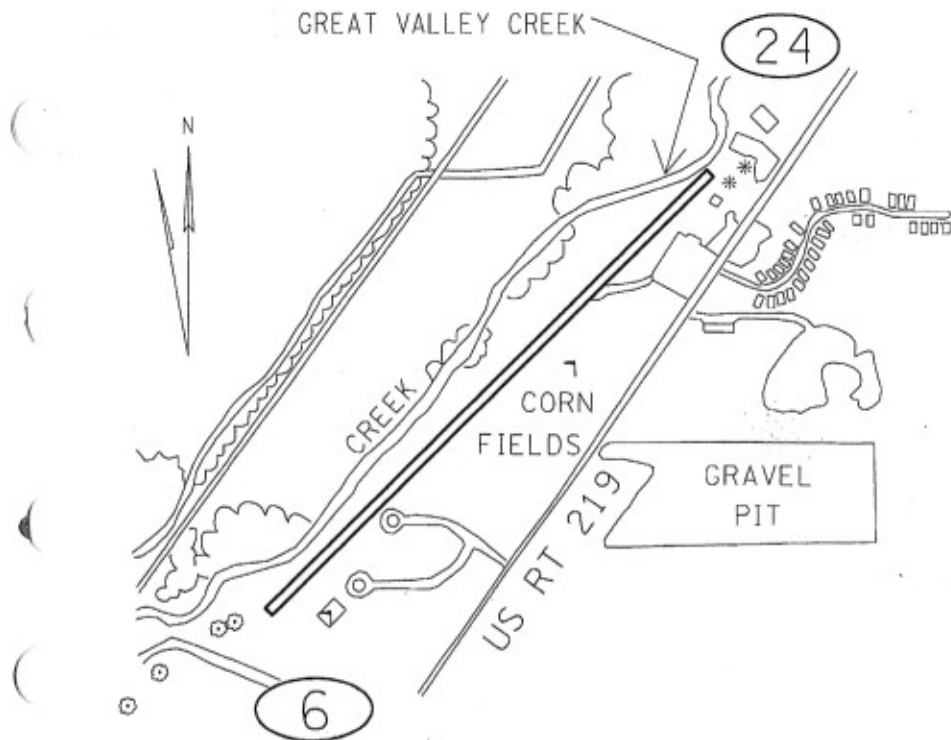
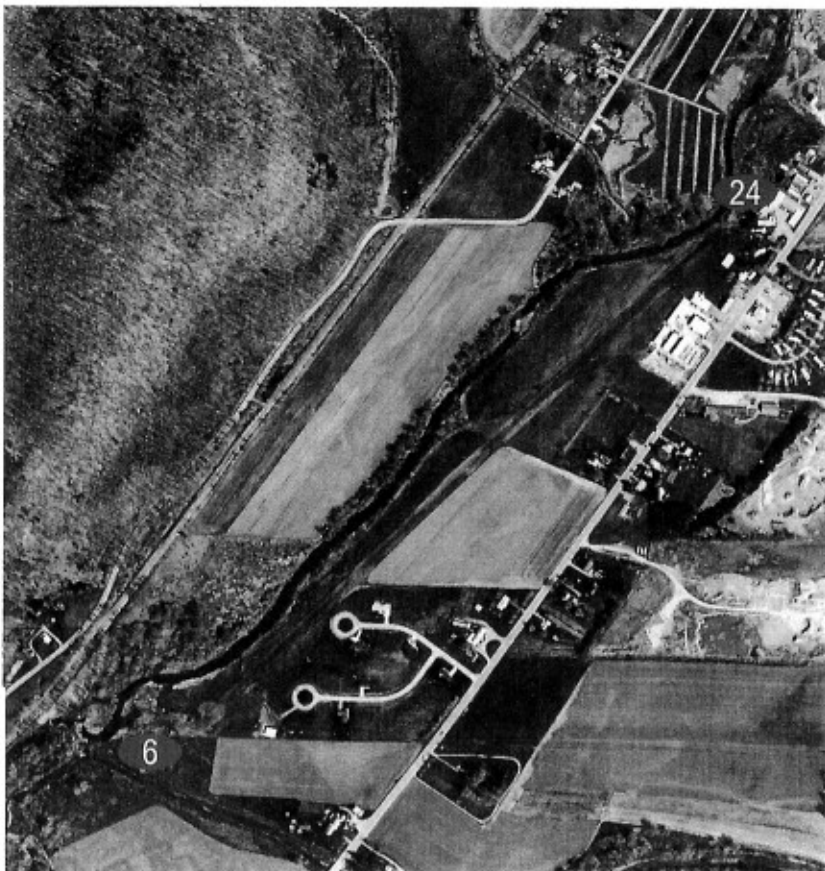
The airport features a very well maintained grass runway (6/24) that is 3800' long by 60' wide. It does have landing lights. The airport is nestled in a valley in the Allegany Mountains. Both ends of the runway are designated as having a right pattern due to substantial hills (small mountains) on both sides. Julie and I landed there recently. They do plan on directing airplanes for parking on fields off of both ends of the runway with golf cart service to the event. Please do not try to pull your airplane into the main tarmac area where the event will be held as there may be numerous members of the general public who are not used to being around airplanes that are running.
